SUBJECT: Missing Person Investigation – Nicholas Garza, age 19

The investigation into the disappearance of Nicholas Garza continued today. There are now a total of five (5) investigators working on the case.

No new leads were developed today.

Investigators are following up on a report and are seeking assistance from the public in identifying the following person:

White Male, early to mid 20's 5'8" to 5'9" in height, thin build, dark hair almost shoulder length hair, wearing a light blue coat with two dark vertical stripes. The person was seen walking north on Rte 23 in Weybridge between 3:30 and 3:40 a.m. on the morning of February 6, 2008, about 1.6 miles north of Pulp Mill Bridge Road. The footprints of the person indicate he came from the area of Weybridge Street in Middlebury.

It is not known if this person has any connection to the disappearance of Nicholas Garza. The Police are interested in identifying this person and are seeking any information he may have.
